Last Season Projected point total: 101.5

Last season finish: **107 (Second in the division)**

Notes: Last years plays and projections were correct. We played the over 101.5 point total and had them projected to finish second in the division. We played them to win the East and the Cup after Tampa Bay was eliminated and cashed on the East. By the time we reached the Cup we already had the Blues allowing us to profit on the hedge. Notes: No significant offseason moves this year for Boston. Marcus Johansson left in free agency after being acquired at the trade deadline. Boston will still produce offensively, but the long playoff run from last year will have an impact on them late in the season and early first round. There are one of two scenarios that happen here: Boston finishes third in the division and loses to Toronto in the first round, or they finish as the first Wild Card team and lose no later than the second round to Tampa Bay. Both scenarios are an early playoff exit.
